On Wednesday, January 11, Thursday, January 26 and Thursday, February 9, students will depart at 2:30 p.m. and ski from approximately 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m., returning to the school at approximately 9:15 p.m.

Lessons are required at Canyon Ski Hill and all students must wear a helmet. All rental packages include a helmet. Approved helmets may be rented at the ski hill for those not needing a ski or snowboard rentals. Students will be responsible for any damaged or lost rental equipment.

Parents are welcome and encouraged to participate! Space on the bus is limited, so parents are encouraged to car pool.

Please note that students may only participate in these sessions if they are meeting the school's academic and behavioral expectations – Being Proactive, Beginning with The End in Mind and Putting First Things First, etc...
